From tomorrow we will suspend trading until at such time as the government issues new guidelines that we feel will protect all concerned. The current guidelines are to be reviewed in 3 weeks (from 23rd March 2020).

We consider a nationwide disruption, however difficult to bear in the coming weeks and months, will allow us all to regroup and prepare for businesses to start up again with renewed energy when the time is right.

The NHS is going to face considerable critical pressure over the coming weeks and months, and we all need to play our part in easing the load wherever possible, protecting our loved ones and one another as much as we possibly can.
